Camp David has offered Presidents and guests phenomenal service for more than 75 years

Since it was selected as a retreat by President Franklin D. Roosevelt in 1942, Camp David has offered world-class services to guests, anticipating their needs and ensuring privacy, relaxation and recreation.

Camp David has offered Presidents an opportunity for solitude and tranquility, as well as an ideal place to host foreign leaders.

President Roosevelt hosted the first head of state visit with Prime Minister Winston Churchill to discuss strategy during World War II.

President Jimmy Carter hosted Egyptian President Anwar al-Sadat and Israeli Prime Minister Menachem Begin. During their stay, he helped negotiate the 1978 Camp David Accords.

In 2000, President Bill Clinton held a summit to continue negotiations for Mid-East peace talks.

President Barack Obama hosted the G8 Summit here in May 2012, the Afghanistan Summit in March 2015 and the Gulf Cooperation Council in May 2015.





Mission & Vision

Naval Support Facility Thurmont provides the President, First Family and guests a safe and secure place for rest, relaxation and rejuvenation.

We embrace the Navy's core values of Honor, Courage and Commitment and the Navy Ethos. Our command's guiding principles are captured by three primary ideas:
Be Safe, Work Hard and Have Fun.

We are a team of professionals who continue to honor the legacy of Camp David by providing world-class service, security and accommodations, while always respecting the great tradition and rich history here.

Through dedication to continuous improvement and teamwork, we have achieved an environment of pride in work, self and organization.

Public Works

NSF Thurmont's Public Works department is responsible for all mechanical, structural and electrical systems on base. Public Works also provides transportation and grounds maintenance services. Department members are responsible for sustainment, restoration and modernization planning. Public Works consists of Sailors in all seven Seabee ratings: BU, CE, CM, EA, EO, SW and UT.

Operations

NSF Thurmont's Operations Department is responsible for fire, electronics and facility maintenance. Ops is divided into several divisions and consists of Sailors in ABF, ABH, CE, DC, EM, EN, ET, IT, MC, MMA and UT ratings.

The Fire division is responsible for aircraft arrival and departures, structural fire protection, fire suppression, sprinklers and alarms. Selected candidates receive training from Goodfellow AFB Fire Academy (NEC 786B) Shore Base Airport & Aircraft Firefighter. Camp David firefighters also have the opportunity to achieve civilian certifications, including Fire Officer I, Hazmat Technician and Hazmat Incident Commander.

Two other divisions made up of Sailors in CE, EM, EN, ET, IT and UT ratings are responsible for in-rate work in a variety of tasks.

Supply

NSF Thurmont's Supply division is divided into three areas of operation: Logistics, Crew-side support and Guest Operations. Supply consists of Sailors in the CS, LS and RS ratings.

Logistics is responsible for hazardous material and financial requirements.

Crew-side supports the operation of all food service spaces and equipment.

Guest Operations provides five-star accommodations to the President, First Family and invited guests.





Administration

NSF Thurmont's administration division consists of Sailors in the NC, PS, and YN ratings.

These Sailors provide pay, personnel and other administrative support to personnel and tenant commands.

Medical

NSF Thurmont's medical division provides comprehensive, acute, routine and preventive health services, including Military Treatment Facilities and network referrals to all beneficiaries.

The division coordinates with the White House Medical Unit to ensure comprehensive health support for the President and First Family during official visits.

Chapel

NSF Thurmont's Chapel provides religious services, counseling and spiritual support to the First Family, guests and NSF Thurmont personnel. The department consists of one RP and a Navy Chaplain.

Recruiting Process

Naval Support Facility Thurmont team members are some of the best in the Fleet. Each member, whether officer or enlisted, is hand-picked from the Fleet to be part of this Presidential team. Team members must be self-motivated, and seek to grow professionally and personally.

The benefits of an assignment to NSF Thurmont are tremendous. Along with the opportunity to directly serve the President, First Family and foreign dignitaries, duty at NSF Thurmont is career-enhancing and offers technical, hands-on experiences.

NSF Thurmont team members include Navy Seabees, logistics specialists, culinary specialists, yeomen, hospital corpsmen, retail services specialists and other support rates.





Eligibility Requirements

Applications to join this select group are accepted throughout the year as billets become available. NSF Thurmont recruits E-1 through E-9 Sailors in the following ratings: ABH, ABF, BU, CE, CM, CS, DC, EA, EM, EN, EO, ET, HM, IT, LS, MMA, MC, NC, PS, RP, RS, SW, UT and YN.

Team members must be well-rounded Sailors who meet certain requirements, and who are recommended for Presidential duty by their chain of command.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must be a U.S. citizen; no dual citizenship
- Recommended that applicant's family have U.S. citizenship
- No felonies
- No NJP within 5 years
- Good credit standing over last 7 years (i.e., no repossession and/or bankruptcy)
- No DUI/DWI within past 10 years
- Must not be under orders
- Must have a driver's license
- Must be able to get and maintain a TS/SCI clearance
- Must be fit for full duty (Any medical concerns will be looked at by NSF Medical prior to approval)
