03-05 COMMAND SLATING BUSINESS RULES

- 1) NRC Command-Screened Officers should submit a ranked Reserve Command Preference Sheet.
- To request a Slate Preference Sheet, please email the NRC Placement Officer, LCDR Anthony Joseph (anthony.m.joseph10.mil@us.navy.mil). 1207 Officers can obtain a slate preference sheet on the 1207 Teams channel.
- Preference Sheets must be submitted to LCDR Joseph and your Detailer <u>NLT 21JUL</u> using the preference sheet template provided.
- 4) Officers will typically be assigned to rank-equivalent or higher Reserve Command
 - I. CDRs
 - i. Eligible for CDR and LCDR NRC Command
 - ii. Must submit ranked preferences for all available CDR Reserve Commands
 - iii. May submit separate ranking for preferred LCDR Reserve Commands
 - iv. <u>CDRs requesting slating who have successfully screened for RTAG Command MUST rank all</u> <u>available RTAGs in addition to the NRCs.</u>
 - II. LCDRs
 - i. Eligible for CDR and LCDR Reserve Command
 - ii. Must submit ranked preferences for all available CDR Reserve Commands
 - iii. Must submit separately ranked preferences for all LCDR Reserve Commands
 - iv. <u>CDR (Selects) requesting slating who have successfully screened for RTAG Command MUST</u> rank all available RTAGs in addition to NRCs.
 - III. LTs
 - i. Eligible for LCDR Reserve Command
 - ii. Must submit ranked preferences for all available LCDR Reserve Commands
- 5) All are encouraged to provide amplifying remarks about rankings on the preference sheet.
- 6) Officers slated to RTAG/NRPDC/NRC Command should expect to begin their training tracks approx. 2-3 months prior to projected fill date. All training is required, unless previously attended within periodicity requirements.
- 7) Candidates <u>must ensure their Chain of Command is informed</u> of intent to submit slate preference sheets, as well as projected fill date and training track, once established.
- 8) If an officer chooses to decline command after screening, a formal declination of command is required IAW MPM 1301-818.
- 9) All billets are subject to change based upon manning requirements or other unforeseen circumstances. In the event that there are more billets than available qualified officers slating, priority will be given to those billets requiring earlier fills.
- 10) All Shore Duty orders are written for 36 months to comply with DODI 1315.8. However, PRDs are subject to change based on the officer's career progression and the needs of the Navy. Notionally, NRC Command tours will last between 30 and 36 months. RTAG XO/CO Fleet Up tours will last 36 months.
