• JUNIOR OFFICER SHORE SLATE PROCESS

Welcome to the Junior Officer Shore Slate process! Your shore billet will be assigned via a competitive slate process. When multiple officers request the same billet, billet assignment is determined through comparison of qualifications, FITREPs, and Commanding Officers' inputs. **Provide your top 20 shore preferences to your Detailer NLT 15 MAY 19.** (If you only provide 5, that indicates that all other billets are a tie for your sixth preference.) Also include what is most important to you (i.e. homeport, type of billet, or command) and if you intend to take DHRB. Officers who have signed DHRB will be considered "Executive Slaters" and are assigned their billet as a single cohort before the slate begins.

*****IMPORTANT CHANGE*****

As we continue to refine the SWO career path to improve our professional development, second tour division officers will no longer fill staff duty. DESRONs, PHIBRONs, and MCMRONs will be filled for 18 months by officers leaving their second division officer tour. Similar to the post Department Head portion of the career path, this means there will be more sea duty requirements on the traditional shore slate.

All officers are required to include (2) DESRON/PHIBRON/MCMRON billets and (1) additional Sea Duty billet in their Top 20 preference. Not providing preferences will not preclude you from possibly slating to a staff. All personal preferences, circumstances, and career implications will be considered as match talent to task.

Following staff duty, officers will be eligible for Executive Slating, and will work one on one with their detailers for follow on orders to match preferences with billet availability. If you are slated to a staff and have signed DHRB, please discuss with your detailer the potential to lock in follow on graduate education at NPS, War College, or other opportunities if availabilities and timing support.

Officers listing "DHRB required" billets in their top six choices do so with the understanding that they will be expected to submit a DHRB contract within 14 days of slate notification of assignment to that billet. Failure to submit a contract will subject that officer to a re-slate. An officer assigned to his/her #7 or higher preference, to a DHRB billet will not be required to sign. While some billets do require DHRB – NROTC, USNA, OLA, and PEP with DLI among others – the majority of billets have no DH commitment requirement. DHRB does not exempt you from GSA assignment.

The WTI program will expand tactical knowledge and watch station experience, and will require a follow-on "production" tour at waterfront shore commands including: NSMWDC, CSCS, ATRC, SWOS, ATG, and various other operational and training commands. The WTI application (to include Commanding Officer's recommendation) should illuminate the candidate's desire and potential to be a successful Warfare Tactics Instructor. If you are interested in becoming a WTI, contact NSMWDC to obtain an application:swi_wti@navy.mil. If selected for the program, officers will receive the KWS AQD. WTI billets are listed on the shore slate by "KWS req." and the type of WTI required post-WTI course of instruction: KW1 is ASW/SUW, KW2 is IAMD, and KW3 is AMW. WTI preferences listed without pending applications or program acceptance will be disregarded.

Please note that MILPERSMAN 1300-302, Change 29 remains in effect. It states, "Members with more than three family members will not normally be assigned to accompany overseas duty, including Alaska and Hawaii, unless a waiver is approved by the Regional Commander of the gaining command." If you have more than three dependents and desire an accompanied overseas assignment, you should be prepared to be deferred to the next shore slate if required. **For CONUS Shore Duty, orders will be written for 36 months IAW the JTR. For sea duty, orders will be written for 24 months; DESRON/PHIBRON/MCMRON for 18 months. Please refer to the Appendix Q of the JTR for specific OCONUS Tour Lengths.**

SWO(N):

Since the nuclear and conventional shore slates are now combined, all SWO(N)s will submit **at least one** nuclear billet in their preferences, regardless of whether or not they have taken/passed their Nuclear Engineer Officer's exam. All nuclear billets are nominative and officers will be approved by Naval Reactors prior to receiving orders. For any questions on this new process, please contact your detailer.

• NOMINATIVE BILLETS

PERS-412 also has several nominative billets available. Post-DIVO SWO JOs select for nominative assignments at an excellent rate. For officers who have sufficient career timing, we provide a follow-on shore tour assignment to include graduate education opportunities at NPS as long as your timing for Department Head School supports another tour. Officers must be endorsed by their reporting senior.

If you are interested, please contact your Detailer to discuss options. Please be prepared to submit (1) full-length photo in service khakis, (2) career biography, (3) contact information-work and personal, (4) any FITREPS missing from your official record. Once an officer has been nominated, he or she cannot be withdrawn from the nominative process except for emergency circumstances (illness, significant injury, etc.). • NAVAL POSTGRADUATE SCHOOL (NPS) – MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA

The SWO community's top priority for Junior Officers during their first shore tour remains the opportunity to earn a graduate education degree. NPS is the best choice for this career milestone due to the flexibility in timing, tailored curricula, and JPME Phase I inclusion. All NPS quotas are available via Talent Management Board and then on a case-by-case based on quota availability.

Academic Profile Code (APC)

The APC is a three-digit code which summarizes pertinent portions of an officer's prior college performance. This code is used to determine an officer's eligibility for an academic program at NPS. Your APC must be calculated before the Detailers can assign you a curriculum quota. Guidance on getting your APC calculated can be found here:

• NPS DISTANCE LEARNING MASTER’S PROGRAM

Master of Systems Analysis Degree Program (MSA, Curriculum 363): The MSA program is designed to meet the needs of the Navy and other services in the Department of Defense (DoD) for technical graduate education in systems analysis as a basis for aiding key decisions on force requirements, weapons systems, and other defense matters. Students acquire foundation skills and hands-on experience in all aspects of analytical studies. MSA grads earn the Navy 3210P subspecialty code, Operations Research Analysis and become eligible to be detailed to 3211-coded Operations Research Analysis – Analysis and Assessment billets. The MSA degree is one of the master’s degrees identified for detailing to 6511P-coded Requirements Management.

Executive Masters of Business Administration (EMBA, Curriculum 805): This program is a defense-focused general management program for senior Department of Navy officers and senior Department of Navy civilians. The program design and course work capitalizes on the current managerial and leadership experience of program participants. The EMBA is a 24-month, part-time, distance learning degree program. Classes meet once a week, approximately 6-7 hours per day, depending on course units. EMBA grads earn the Navy 3100P subspecialty code, Financial Management-Defense Focus.

The distance learning programs require VTC participation generally on Tuesdays (West Coast) and Thursdays (East Coast). Officers need to work with their current or gaining shore command to ensure VTC activities will be supported. All other course requirements will be completed during off duty hours. Distance learning programs kick off each Spring and Fall with specific application time lines for each class up. Officers will incur a three year OBLISERV following graduation and must sign DHRB if assigned to SMWDC, SWOS, ATG, CSCS, CSG4, ATRC and NPTU

NOTE 1: IAW OPNAVINST 1520.23C, the service obligation commences upon completion of or withdrawal from an education program and will be served concurrently with any other service obligation.

• JOINT PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION (JPME) PHASE ONE

If you intend to continue your career as a Department Head (or if you’re still undecided), we strongly recommend that you complete your Joint Professional Military Education (JPME) Phase One certification while on shore duty. JPME is an essential element of the Goldwater-Nichols Act of 1986 which mandates joint service and war fighting education requirements for all services that were linked to important career milestones for military officers.

JPME Phase One completion is a discriminator for selection at the Commander Command Afloat (XO/CO Fleet Up) Selection Board, and is required to be completed prior to taking O-5 command. The SWO community considers the post-DIVO shore tour as the best opportunity/timeframe for officers to earn their graduate degrees as well as JPME Phase One. Below are the various options for completion of JPME Phase One:

- Naval Postgraduate School (integrated into most degree programs, optional with all others)
