

# PERS-41 FY27 NROTC Commanding Officer Slate

## REQUIREMENTS

- All Captains who apply must have a Master's Degree and meet academic standards required by the particular institution.

## ELIGIBILITY

- The associated fill date must align to your PRD or be supported by your command.
- Preference is given to post-Major Commanders (PMCs) who have completed their PMC1 tour, followed by PMCs leaving Major Command, followed by O6s with at least 2 years remaining before statutory retirement rotating from Sea Duty, Overseas Assignments, and Major Staffs.
  - ***Officers who are in the Major Command "bank" and awaiting slating for Major Command will not be considered.***

## HOW TO APPLY

- Email LCDR Rob Van Winter the following information:
  - Universities you are interested in ranked in order. Please note, you will only be considered for institutions you rank.
  - Confirmation you meet the fill requirements.
- If selected, you will be asked to provide your transcripts, official photo, security clearance information, and biography to NROTC Placement for Naval Service Training Command (NSTC) and university review and approval.

University of Missouri	August 2027	Masters Required; GPA – 3.0 Masters
University of Michigan	August 2027	Masters Required
University of Washington	August 2027	Masters Required; GPA – 3.0 Masters
University of Minnesota	September 2027	Masters Required; GPA – 3.0 Masters

Notes:

1. Fill dates may have some flexibility.
2. There may be additional requirements in place for certain institutions (eg. letters of recommendation, interviews, etc.)
3. GPA requirements may be waived for some institutions.
