1. Date and Location

- a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as president, the officers listed in enclosure (1) as members, and the personnel listed in enclosure (2) as administrative support staff, is ordered to convene at Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 0800, 4 December 2024, or as soon as practicable thereafter.
- b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-26 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).
- 2. Function. The function of the board is to:
- a. Recommend Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Officers (114X and 648X) for Commanding Officer (CO).
 - b. Recommend EOD Officers (114X and 648X) for Executive Officer (XO).
- c. Review the performance of previously selected EOD Officers in the CO and XO banks, and reaffirm or remove, as applicable.
- d. Adjudicate officers who have petitioned the board, in writing, for a special additional look. A special additional fourth look will be available upon petition when the constituent can show that he/she was somehow disadvantaged, or that his/her record was unfairly considered during the normal administrative screening process. The petition is made in writing to the board

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president, via Navy Personnel Command (NAVPERSCOM (PERS-41)), who will attach an endorsement recommending inclusion or exclusion of the petitioner's record for an additional look. Officers approved for an additional look by a majority of the board members will then be considered with those officers receiving regular consideration.

- e. Recommend officers who have petitioned the board, in writing, for a Delayed Look. A Delayed Look will be available upon petition when the constituent can show that he/she was somehow disadvantaged, or that his/her record would be unfairly considered during the normal screening process at the first look. Petition is made in writing to the selection board president, via NAVPERSCOM (PERS-41), who will attach an endorsement recommending inclusion or exclusion of the petitioner's record for the current board. Officers approved for a "Delayed Look" by majority of the board members will then be considered first look eligible with those officers receiving regular first look eligible consideration on the next scheduled administrative screening board.
- 3. <u>Board Authorized Selections</u>. CO and XO screening goals are derived from projected fill requirements and officers in each respective bank.

a. Commanding Officer

- (1) Eligibility is based on the following criteria:
 - (a) Promoted to or Senate confirmed for promotion to the rank of Commander (O-5).
- (b) Awarded the KG6 Additional Qualification Designator (AQD) and completed the XO tour.
- (c) Have been eligible for the EOD CO Administrative screening board less than three times without selection.
- (d) Have completed the EOD Command Qualification Panel and have been awarded the 2D1 AQD, per references (b) and (c).
- (2) Eligibility via an Additional (Fourth) Look Requests. Officers who have appeared before the EOD CO Administrative Screening Board three times without selection are authorized to petition the board for an additional look. Petitions will be submitted in writing to the Board President via PERS-41. All petitions submitted will be presented to the board for consideration into the eligibility pool and voted upon prior to reviewing any records. Determination of eligibility will be decided by YES/NO vote, where a majority YES vote results in inclusion into the eligibility pool.
 - (3) Selection Goals. Seven 1140 and/or 6480 for a total of seven CO selects.

b. Executive Officer

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 - (1) Eligibility is based on the following criteria:
- (a) Promoted to or Senate confirmed for promotion to the rank of Lieutenant Commander (O-4).
 - (b) Qualified as an EOD Officer (KG5 AQD):
 - (c) Administratively screened for EOD DH (KG0 AQD).
- (d) Have been eligible for the EOD XO Administrative Screening Board less than three times without selection.
- (e) Must have completed nine years of commissioned service prior to the start of the board.
- (2) Eligibility via an Additional (Fourth) Look Requests. Officers who have appeared before the EOD XO Administrative Screening Board three times without selection are authorized to petition the board for an additional look. Petitions will be submitted in writing to the Board President via PERS-41. All petitions submitted will be presented to the board for consideration into the eligibility pool and voted upon prior to reviewing any records. Determination of eligibility will be decided by YES/NO vote, where a majority YES vote results in inclusion into the eligibility pool.
- (3) Eligibility of officers returning from a break in service. Officers who have recently returned from service following Career Intermission Program or returned to active duty will be afforded an opportunity to submit a current FITREP with a 6 month reporting period prior to their first look. If less than 6 months, the officer will be delayed to the next administrative board.
 - (4) Selection Goals. 11 1140 and one 6480 for a total of 12 XO selects.
- 4. <u>Additional Guidance</u>. The below information is provided to clarify community requirements and any specific needs, but in no way should replace the best and fully qualified standard of reference (a).
- a. NAVADMIN 247/19 requires that all unrestricted line officers complete Joint Professional Military Education Phase I prior to assuming O-5 command for which the command-at-sea insignia is authorized. Due consideration to this requirement shall be made when selecting officers for command.
- b. In accordance with references (b) and (c), all EOD officers considered by the FY-26 EOD CO Administrative Screen Board must have completed the EOD Officer Command Qualification Panel and have been awarded the 2D1 AQD to be eligible for command screening.

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- 5. <u>Service Colleges</u>. All officers screened for EOD XO will be considered screened for senior service colleges.
- 6. Official Navy Record Markup Program (ONRMP). The Official Navy Record Markup Program (ONRMP) will be utilized to "pre-markup" records with fitness report trend lines, individual trait averages above reporting senior's cumulative average, rank changes, and tour lines. The board member assigned is responsible for ensure ONRMP's accuracy during record reviews.
- 7. The board need not select to the numbers provided. The authorized number to select shall only be attained if there are a sufficient number of candidates determined fully qualified.

- b. Adjudicate officers who have petitioned the board, in writing, for a special additional look. A special additional fourth look will be available upon petition when the constituent can show that he/she was somehow disadvantaged, or that his/her record was unfairly considered during the normal administrative screening process. The petition is made in writing to the board president, via Navy Personnel Command (NAVPERSCOM (PERS-41)), who will attach an endorsement recommending inclusion or exclusion of the petitioner's record for an additional look. Officers approved for an additional look by a majority of the board members will then be considered with those officers receiving regular consideration.
- c. Recommend officers who have petitioned the board, in writing, for a Delayed Look. A Delayed Look will be available upon petition when the constituent can show that he/she was somehow disadvantaged, or that his/her record would be unfairly considered during the normal screening process at the first look. Petition is made in writing to the selection board president, via NAVPERSCOM (PERS-41), who will attach an endorsement recommending inclusion or

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exclusion of the petitioner's record for the current board. Officers approved for a "Delayed Look" by majority of the board members will then be considered first look eligible with those officers receiving regular first look eligible consideration on the next scheduled administrative screening board.

- 3. Board Authorized Selections. DH screening goals are not limited.
 - a. Department Head
 - (1) Eligibility is based on the following criteria:
- (a) Officers will receive their first "look" (1st look) for EOD DH beginning at Years of Commissioned Service (YCS) 6, followed by subsequent looks at YCS 7 (2nd look) and YCS 8 (3rd look).
 - (b) Qualified as an EOD Officer (KG5 AQD).
- (c) Be recommended by their Commanding Officer for EOD DH in accordance with reference (b).
- (d) Have less than three record screenings for EOD DH from previous administrative screening boards.
- (2) Eligibility via an Additional (Fourth) Look Requests. Officers who have appeared before the EOD DH Administrative Screening Board three times without selection are authorized to petition the board for an additional look. Petitions will be submitted in writing to the Board President via PERS-41. All petitions submitted will be presented to the board for consideration into the eligibility pool and voted upon prior to reviewing any records. Determination of eligibility will be decided by YES/NO vote, where a majority YES vote results in inclusion into the eligibility pool.
 - (3) Selection Goals. No limit on EOD DH selection quotas.
- 4. <u>Service Colleges</u>. All officers screened for EOD DH will be considered screened for junior service colleges.
- 5. Official Navy Record Markup Program (ONRMP). The Official Navy Record Markup Program (ONRMP) will be utilized to "pre-markup" records with fitness report trend lines, individual trait averages above reporting senior's cumulative average, rank changes, and tour lines. The board member assigned is responsible for ensure ONRMP's accuracy during record reviews.
