

Cryptologic Technician Interpretive (CTI) Conversion and “A” School Requests

Updated APRIL 2024

General CTI conversion information:

Conversion to CTI can be a lengthy process and Sailors will continue to compete for advancement in their current rating until CTI training is complete.

Note: Sailors will not normally be released from language training to attend Leadership Development Courses (LDC) required for advancement. Sailors should make all possible effort to attend LDC prior to departing their current command.

Upon graduation from CTI “A” school at Defense Language Institute (DLI), Sailors will attend the cryptologic portion of training at Goodfellow AFB in San Angelo, TX. Training at DLI lasts from 1 to 1.5 years, depending on the language, and follow-on training at Goodfellow lasts ~3 months.

New CTI’s are typically stationed at one of five primary duty stations in Maryland, Georgia, Texas, Hawaii or Korea and the majority of billets for individual languages are located at the same operational sites. Therefore, CTI’s can expect to spend a significant portion of their careers in one location. This concentration of billets makes spouse co-location with non-CT Sailors and other service branch members extremely difficult. There are also some limited opportunities for assignment overseas.

Sea duty for CTI’s includes temporary assignments aboard surface ships and submarines as well as aircrew duty and tours with Naval Special Warfare. All applicants for CTI are required to volunteer for duty involving aerial flight and for duty onboard submarines. No medical screening for either program is required prior to acceptance. Sailors who are later found to be Not Physically Qualified (NPQ) for either program will not normally lose their rating.

NOTES:

CTI does not participate in the STAR program. Sailors should convert to CTI using the “OBLISERV to Train” (OTT) option, if eligible. Information on the OTT program can be found in MILPERSMAN 1306-604 and associated references. OBLISERV will be 5 years (60 months) from language course start date.

Security eligibility requirements will NOT be waived. The member MUST be a US citizen (no waivers) and all immediate family members must be either a US citizen or the citizen of a country on the Low Threat Matrix listed in Intelligence Community Directive 704 (ICD-704).

Conversion to CTI requires screening by a C10F/FCC Special Security Representative, even if the member already possesses a TS or TS/SCI clearance. No final determination will be made until this review is complete. DO NOT submit clearance via the local command, this may delay the process. The CTI ECM will forward the SF86 to a C10F/FCC Special Security Representative, who will expedite review under C10F/FCC funding.

CTI Conversion Package Checklist

Eligibility Requirements:

Security (NO WAIVERS)

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
- All of the applicant's immediate family must be a U.S. citizen or a citizen of a country on the Low Threat Matrix listed in the current ICD-704.

Academic (Waivers on a case by case basis)

- ASVAB Composite of VE + MK ≥ 126 **or**
- ASVAB Composite of GS+MK+VE ≥ 162 **and**
Defense Language Aptitude Battery (DLAB) standard score ≥ 110

Service

- Pay grade E-5 or below (will consider E-6 Sailors)
- No more than 10 years of service

Performance

- Evaluation marks at least "3.0" or higher and promotion recommendation of "P" or higher for past 36 months
- Meets PFA/BCA standards
- Clean record for 36 months prior to request

Physical

- Normal hearing
- Worldwide assignable

Package Documentation Requirements:

- 1306/7 requesting conversion to CTI
- Copy of DLAB score
- Copy of ASVAB scores
- Page 13 volunteering for Aircrew Duty per MILPERSMAN 1220-010 (Sample text below)
- Page 13 volunteering for Submarine Duty per MILPERSMAN 1306-402 (Sample text below)
- Copies of evaluations for past 36 months
- PRIMS PFA and BCA Data for the past 4 PFA cycles

- Copy of SF-86 (Request for Security Clearance) *****DO NOT SUBMIT VIA CURRENT COMMAND*****

Optional Documentation:

- Defense Language Proficiency Test results – Must be less than one year since test
- Request for waiver – If applicant does not meet all requirements, waiver requests must be included

Conversion to CTI can be a lengthy process due to the security review requirement. Delays may also occur as a result of incomplete package submissions. Please ensure all required documents are included when submitting requests.

Applicants will not be approved for conversion in to the CTI rating unless they are approved for conversion out of their current rating.

Submitting via local command will result in further delays. **It is recommended that the completed SF86 be submitted separately from the conversion package to the CTI TECHAD/ECM, either by encrypted email or via the DoD SAFE share portal.**

 - a. Be able to perform extensive daily calisthenics.
 - b. Pass a Navy PFA with a "good" in all categories for my age and gender.
 - c. Swim:
 - (1) 1 mile in flight suit in 80 minutes or less using sidestroke, breaststroke, or American crawl.
 - (2) 100 yards in full flight gear (flight suit, boots, helmet, gloves, and deflated life preserver) using each of the survival strokes for 25 yards (sidestroke, breaststroke, elementary backstroke, and American crawl), followed immediately by a 5-minute drown-proofing (face-down prone float).
 - (3) In full flight gear, tread water for 2 minutes followed immediately by 3 minutes of drown-proofing.
 - (4) 200 yards (50 yards each using breaststroke, elementary backstroke, sidestroke, and American crawl).
 - (5) Jump from a 12-foot tower and then swim 15 yards underwater wearing flight suit and boots using a modified breaststroke, immediately followed by floating using trouser inflation techniques.
 - (6) 75-yard flight equipment swim using breaststroke only.
 - (7) 100-yard swim using 25 yards sidestroke, 25 yards breaststroke, 25 yards elementary backstroke, and 25 yards American crawl. Initial: _____
