

Uniformed Services University (USU), College of Allied Health Sciences (CAHS) Degree Path Completion Checklist

If you attend or have attended Navy Medicine training programs affiliated with USU-CAHS, you may be eligible to complete an associate's or a baccalaureate degree, depending on the training program you have attended.

Degree Completion Checklist

- You are enrolled in or have completed one or more of the Navy Medicine USU-CAHS affiliated programs. Check USU-CAHS website for a complete listing of affiliated programs.
- Contact a USU-CAHS Student Advisor (see below contacts) to determine if you are eligible for a degree. If so, request any general education courses needed to transfer to USU-CAHS to complete degree path.
- Send official Joint Services Transcript (JST) to USU-CAHS Registrar through the CAHS Academic Advisor.
- Send all official college transcripts to USU-CAHS Registrar for college courses already completed.
- Complete any remaining credits at an accredited college or via testing such as the College Level Examination Program (CLEP).
- Contact Student Advisor to verify all degree requirements are fulfilled.
- Submit graduation application for the next USU-CAHS graduation cycle.

Note: The Sailor has five years or until they get out of the Navy to complete degree path.
