Subj: CONDITIONAL RELEASE FROM THE HOSPITAL CORPS, RECOMMENDED

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 1420.1B

- 1. In an effort to stream line the processing of requests and reduce administrative routing timelines for Hospital Corpsman applying to "stay Navy" commissioning programs, the Hospital Corps Enlisted Community Manager (HM ECM) has issued this memorandum. Per reference (a), this memo serves as a recommended "approved" conditional release from the Hospital Corps for the following Academic Year (AY) and Fiscal Year (FY) transitional programs:
  - a. AY26 Medical Enlisted Commissioning Program (MECP)
  - b. AY26 Medical Service Corps In service Procurement Program (MSC-IPP)
  - c. AY26 Enlisted to Medical Degree Preparatory Program (EMPD2)
  - d. AY26 United States Naval Academy / Naval Academy Preparatory School
  - e. FY25 Human Resources In Service Procurement Program
  - f. FY25/26 Officer Candidate School (OCS)
  - g. FY25/26 Supply Corps
  - h. FY25/26 Surface Warfare Officer
- 2. Hospital Corpsman do not need to submit a NAVPERS 1306/7 for conditional release if applying to one of the listed programs. Please include this memorandum with member's application package to show proof of conditional release.
- 3. To prevent potential future administrative impacts for the applicant, once positively screened for a program or selected, personnel must inform the ECM of their selections status within 30 days of being accepted via email at HM ECM@navy.mil.
- 4. This memorandum is valid only for the AY/FY and programs noted in paragraphs 1.a. through 1.h. above. All other conditional release requests should be submitted on a NAVPERS 1306/7 in accordance with applicable policies and procedures.
