- 2. Initial entry enlisted Navy EOD candidates are required to meet the PST minimum scores outlined in Table 1 to receive a contract. Fleet conversion applicants are required to meet the PST minimum scores outlined in Table 2. All candidates are required to meet the PST minimum scores outlined in table 2 to maintain program eligibility throughout the initial pipeline.
- This change will remain in effect until rescinded by BUPERS-3 or updates are made to MILPERSMAN 1220-410. This memo rescinds the previous Temporary Change to the Navy Explosive Ordnance Disposal Physical Screening Test Standards for Enlisted Candidates, dated 28 Jan 25.
