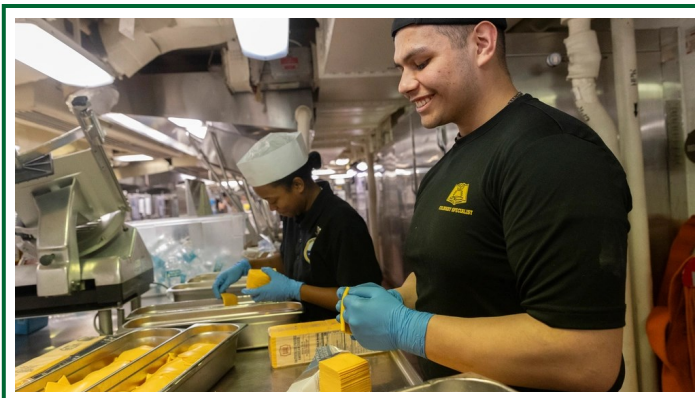

Permanent Change of Station (PCS) funding is running low due to the new Continuing Resolution (CR). Expect hard copy PCS orders to be released less than two months in advance of your transfer. This does not apply to Sailors receiving orders in the Senior Enlisted Marketplace or orders that are "No-Cost." Those orders should be released without delay. Additionally, SDIP is no longer authorized for Sailors selecting orders in the Senior Enlisted Marketplace.
