

## CWO 783X (INTELLIGENCE)

**DESIGNATOR DESCRIPTION**

CWO Intelligence Technicians (7831s) are both technical and subject matter experts in the Core Competency Areas (CCAs) of Counterintelligence/Human Intelligence (CI/HUMINT), Geospatial Interpretation (GEOINT)/Targeting, and Operational Intelligence (OPINTEL). They lead, direct, manage and train intelligence personnel in assembling and analyzing CI/HUMINT reports; providing GEOINT and/or Targeting support, and analyzing & reporting all-source OPINTEL of surface, sub-surface, and air activity in maritime and expeditionary environments for our warfighters and decision-makers at the tactical, operational and strategic levels as they progress and promote through their careers, beginning at the tactical, Echelon V- and IV-level commands, e.g. SRT-1/2, CVN/LHA as CWO2s and CWO3s, up to strategic, Echelon II-level commands, such as COMPACFLT, assigned w/Maritime Ops. Centers (MOC)s.

CWO Intel Techs will serve as, but are not limited to initially serving as Instructors, Troop Leads, Intelligence Officers, Division Officers, Imagery- or Targeting Officers, as Fleet Info. Warfare Officers, or as Asst. Shipboard Intel. Officers (ASIO)s. More senior positions may include N2X/J2X, Fleet Targeteers, Collection Managers, Chiefs of Targets, Department Head positions as Directors of Intelligence (N2/J2), or as Officers-in-Charge. At each paygrade, 7831 CWOs should expect to have dual-hat responsibilities as Advisors specific to their respective CCA for operators, N2s and for Flag- and General Officers. Career progression includes a diverse mix of both sea/operational and shore duty assignments at the CWO2/3 levels and majority shore-based assignments at the CWO4/5 levels.
