

## LDO 6320 (AVIATION OPERATIONS)

### DESIGNATOR DESCRIPTION

Aviation Operations Limited Duty Officers serve as officer technical/tactical specialists in Anti-submarine, Anti-surface, and Reconnaissance aviation operations for Carrier based assets and shore based Maritime Patrol and Reconnaissance aircraft. They assist in the organization, planning, supervision, and direction of TacMobile Operations in fixed-based and expeditionary environments supporting operations, brief and debrief operational flight crews, evaluate and determine in flight operational efficiency of sensor system components; supervise preflight, in flight and post flight inspection of equipment; devise and implement operational planning requirements for Carrier Strike Group staffs. They employ a broad knowledge of the characteristics and employment of U. S. and foreign submarines, warships, smallcraft, and merchant ships and principles of radar magnetic detection, electronic countermeasures, and underwater acoustics.

They may serve as, but are not limited only to serving as, CVN Tactical Action Officer, TacMobile Watch Officer, Carrier Strike Group Staff Officers, Tactical Operations Center Officers In Charge, Executive/Commanding Officers both Aviation and Major Command, in various operational and staff billets.
