Bandmaster Limited Duty Officers serve as officer technical managers in the field of music and all phases of program management and band operations. They exercise technical and managerial supervision, and develop plans and policies for Navy Music including personnel, supply, fiscal and travel programs, and training requirements for Navy Musician (MU) personnel. They employ a broad technical knowledge of instrumental and vocal performance, band administration and operation, musical techniques, theories and literature, protocol, ceremonial support, and inventory maintenance including procurement, distribution, repair, as well as shipping and receiving of equipment.

They may serve as, but are not limited to, Director/Fleet Bandmaster of Navy bands, program management, and CO/XO shore activities, providing information and administrative assistance in music and protocol matters, and direct support of official ceremonies, outreach priorities, and theater security cooperation/diplomacy initiatives.
