

## LDO 6480 (EXPLOSIVE ORDNANCE)

### DESIGNATOR DESCRIPTION

Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Limited Duty Officers are technical leaders and managers who develop and mentor the EOD force, ensuring combat readiness for global operations. Their expertise encompasses explosive ordnance, expeditionary diving, and detecting, identifying, and eliminating explosive threats on land and in water, including chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear (CBRN) threats. Overall, they are responsible for the generation of readiness, shaping and administering readiness policy, managing training, and evaluating combat readiness.

They may serve as but are not limited to, EOD Platoon Leaders, Training and Readiness Officers at an Explosive Ordnance Disposal Mobile Unit, Group, or TYCOM, and Commanding and Executive Officers at EOD training commands.
