

LDO 653X (CIVIL ENGINEER CORPS)

Civil Engineer Corps Limited Duty Officers serve as technical managers in the operational fields of expeditionary and enduring horizontal and vertical construction, facilities maintenance, utilities, and automotive and construction equipment maintenance and repair. They plan, coordinate, and direct the technical, operational, equipment maintenance, training, and administrative responsibilities of Naval Construction Force units. They supervise personnel engaged in horizontal and vertical construction, maintenance, and repair, including buildings, airfields, waterfront structures, and, utility systems.

Experience in these disciplines is acquired through career development, operational/expeditionary tours, and acquired education. They may serve as Commanding Officers of Construction Battalion Maintenance Units (CBMU) and Naval Construction Training Centers (NCTC), Chief Staff Officers with Naval Construction Regiments (NCR), Executive Officers at an NCTC, Training Officers for Naval Construction Group (NCG), Officers-in-Charge of details and detachments, or in various operational and staff billets with other expeditionary commands.

A Seabee Combat Warfare (SCW) designation is typically earned in their first or second tour while assigned to an NMCB or ACB.
