

DEVGRU SAILOR ENGAGEMENT

Target audience: Sailors of all paygrades in the following rates:

AD, AE, AG, AM, AT, AW, BU, CE, CM, CTI, CTM, CTR, CTT, CWT, EA, EM, EN, EO, ET, FC, FCA, GM, HM, IC, IS, IT, LS, MA, MC, NC, ND, PR, PS, RP, RW, SW, UT, YN and PACT Sailors.

This presentation will provide a career enhancing opportunity for you or your Sailors to support an elite unit at the National Strategic level, as well as a general overview of the command, the requirements, the screening process, the training pipeline and information on how to prepare to be selected for orders at DEVGRU to support a very unique command in your rate. BILLET-BASED ADVANCEMENT

Target audience: All hands

Billet-Based Advancement enables Sailors to advance to the next higher paygrade via Command Advance to Position (CA2P), Advance to Position (A2P) and the Senior Enlisted Marketplace (SEM). BBA expands Sailor choice of assignment, reduces the number of E-5 and above vacancies, and lessens the number of assignment misalignments.

U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY (USNA)

Target audience: Enlisted Sailors

For junior enlisted Sailors interested in attending the U.S. Naval Academy. Degree programs are geared toward science and engineering. To be eligible, you must be a U.S. citizen under age 23 on July 1 of your year of entry, and you must not have any legal obligation to support a child or another individual.

ENLISTED LEADER DEVELOPMENT

Target audience: Senior enlisted leaders

Senior enlisted leaders across the fleet have worked together to develop the Enlisted Leader Development (ELD) framework -- a "character focused" learning continuum for our enlisted force, based on foundational courses delivered throughout an enlisted Sailor's career: SAILOR 360, self-study, on-the-job training (OJT) and feedback received from coaches, mentors, and advocates. ELD describes all aspects of enlisted leadership skills training, character development, decision making, self-awareness, and ethics. Effective leader development occurs when a member participates in leadership development activities, formal education, reading or viewing leadership-related material, discussing leadership issues, observing leaders in action, and performing as a leader, including both formal training and self-directed study and reflection. NAVY WOUNDED WARRIOR

Target audience: All hands

Navy Wounded Warrior (NWW) is the Navy's sole organization for coordinating the non-medical care of seriously wounded, ill and injured Sailors and Coast Guardsmen, and providing resources and support to their families. Through proactive leadership, the program provides individually tailored assistance designed to optimize the success of the wounded warriors' recovery, rehabilitation and reintegration activities.

PERS-4 DETAILING PROCESS / ENLISTED DISTRIBUTION

Target audience: Enlisted Sailors

Listen and interact with representatives and subject matter experts regarding critical details on how enlisted personnel are assigned to commands throughout the fleet. Learn how you can plan and develop career priorities that align closely to both individual and family needs while the Navy ensures a "best fit" to reconcile force manning priorities.

RECRUIT DIVISION COMMANDER DUTY

Target audience: Enlisted Sailors E-5 and above

RDCs are hard charging Navy professionals to transform civilians into Sailors. E5 & above are eligible for the #1 Sailorization and Mentoring shore duty that the Navy has to offer. In addition to the immeasurable professional development and personal gratification, RDSC's will also receive SDAP, up to 24 months waived off their follow-on sea tour, as well as post tour choice of coast after a successful Recruit Training Command assignment (RTC).

NAVY CREDENTIALING OPPORTUNITIES ON-LINE (NAVY COOL)

Target audience: All hands

Navy COOL (Credentialing Opportunities On-Line) helps Navy service members find information on certifications and licenses related to their military occupation and civilian careers. Navy COOL can also be used by Recruiters, Counselors, Credentialing Organizations, and Employers.

U.S. NAVAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Target audience: Enlisted Sailors

The U.S. Naval Community College (USNCC) works with active-duty enlisted Sailors, Marines, and Coast Guardsmen as well as Coast Guard Reservists to apply credits earned from military training and prior education toward their associate degree. The USNCC provides a five-course Naval Studies Certificate that counts as 15 of the 60 credits required for associate degrees. With the program's addition of the U.S. Coast Guard, Coast Guardsmen will also be able to access the USNCC.
