



### **PAY**


Navy SELRES are paid for four days of Active Duty for only two days of work



# EDUCATION BENEFITS

### **MGIB-SR**

A free education benefit for SELRES officer and enlisted Sailors who agree to serve 6-years in a SELRES status

### **NAVY COOL**


Earn certifications and licenses while serving in the SELRES: Available to officers and enlisted

### **TRANSFER POST 9/11 GI BILL**

Eligibility can be obtained to transfer your Post 9/11 GI Bill to your dependents while serving in the Selected Reserves; incurs a four-year drilling obligation in the SELRES

### "A" AND "C" SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES

Sailors who change their rating can be eligible to attend required formal schooling. Certain billets may also require NEC obtainment or "C" school completion



### OTHER BENEFITS

### **UNIFORMS**

- -IRR must keep uniforms serviceable
- -Enlisted SELRES eligible for partial sea bag issue, one for one swap for unserviceable items

### LIFE INSURANCE (SELRES)

- -SGLI offered for SELRES up to \$500K, premium \$30/mo
- -Dependents eligible for FSGLI up to \$100K spouse, \$10K each child

### **BASE AND OTHER AMENITIES**


MWR, commissary, exchange, Fleet and Family Service Centers, Military/Navy lodging, Psychological Health Outreach Program, Military One Source, etc.

### **NETWORKING, CONNECTION**


Maintain military affiliation, camaraderie. Connect with other Sailors for expanded civilian/professional opportunities. Strong Reserve mentorship networks

### **USERRA Protections**


By law, your status as a member of the military is protected and as such, an employer may not discriminate against you based on that service in any way. While on orders, your civilian job is protected.




### UNIFORMED SERVICE EMPLOYMENT AND REEMPLOYMENT RIGHTS ACT (USERRA)




- Federal law that establishes rights and responsibilities for uniformed Service members and their civilian employers









### DEPLOYMENT DEFERMENT

### RECEIVE A TWO-YEAR INVOLUNTARY MOBILIZATION DEFERMENT

If you join the Navy Reserve you will receive a two-year deferment from involuntary mobilization commencing on the date of affiliation with the Selected Reserve.

Reservists can potentially be deployed during service. There is no formula for determining who will deploy or when, where or for how long.



# FULL-TIME OPTIONS


### **ACTIVE DUTY OPPORTUNITIES**

Voluntary temporary recalls to active duty (Definite Recall) for durations of 1-3 years are available. While on these orders the Sailor will earn full Active Duty pay and benefits

Voluntary Active Duty for Operational Support (ADOS) and Active Duty for Training (ADT) allows periods of active duty in a variety of capacities

Indefinite Recall, aka Training and Administration of the Reserve (TAR) program, is a path back to full-time active duty

### ENTRY PROCESS FOR THOSE WHO'VE SERVED BEFORE

The process of affiliating with the Navy Reserve is relatively simple, as recruiters will guide you through the process and help you determine whether you qualify as a NAVET (Navy Veteran), a OSVET (Other Service Veteran) or for any of the other related entrance programs.

As a military veteran — NAVET or OSVET — you must be able to complete 20 years of service by age 60. You can discuss the specifics of your individual situation with your recruiter, find out whether you're eligible and be advised on next steps.

### SECURE PRIOR SERVICE DOCUMENTATION


If you've served before and are interested in the Navy Reserve, you'll want to get a copy of your DD 214 form and make sure the information in it is complete and correct. To obtain a copy of your DD 214, simply submit form SF-180, Request Pertaining to Military Records.

### **EXPECT INITIAL PROCESSING**

NAVETs and OSVETs will not be required to complete prerequisite training requirements to affiliate with the Navy Reserve. However, there will be a need to report for administrative processing and uniform fitting.
