- ☐ Original Permanent Release Order (DD 2718) signed from the command directing permanent release
 - 1. Verbal requests will **NOT** be accepted.
 - 2. Submit a Permanent Release Order as soon as pre-trial confinement is no longer necessary, to the Brig Parole and Release office. Pre-trial prisoners must be released on the date the letter is signed and letters cannot be pre-dated for release on a later date. The letter <u>MUST</u> be signed by the Commanding Officer or Acting Commanding Officer. This authority **CANNOT** be delegated.
 - 3. Bring the original request to the Brig Receiving and Release office when picking up the prisoner.
