NOTE: New confinements and permanent releases do **NOT** require certified Brig chasers for escort purposes. Temporary releases **DO** require certified Brig chasers.

DISCLAIMER: Failure to provide all required items below at time of intended temporary release may result delay of the temporary release.

Qualified Brig Chaser(s) to conduct temporary release mission

FAX or E-mail from command requesting the temporary release.

1. Verbal requests will **NOT** be accepted.
2. Submit FAX or e-mail **AT LEAST 24 HOURS** in advance of intended temporary release time to the Brig Parole and Release office **AND** Receiving and Release. This request **CAN** be signed/submitted "By Direction."
3. Bring original request to the Brig Receiving and Release office on the day of temporary release.

NOTE: Temporary releases are normally for periods of time **LESS THAN 24 HOURS** in length. If you intend to temporarily release a prisoner for **MORE THAN 24 HOURS**, please contact NAVCONBRIG Miramar's Receiving and Release office at DSN 307-7011/Comm (858) 307-7011 for guidance concerning overnight confinement requirements, etc.

NOTE: For Pre-trial prisoners, commands **MUST** bring appropriate service uniform for court appearance, if not already at the facility. Provide ample time for the prisoner to change before being temporary released.

Valid reasons for temporary release:

- (1) Pre-Trial prisoner must attend a court appearance
- (2) Pre-Trial prisoner must complete administrative processing at parent command
- (3) Pre-Trial prisoner must attend a mental health examination
- (4) Pre-Trial prisoner must attend a medical/dental appointment

Invalid/unacceptable reasons for temporary release:

- (1) Pre-Trial prisoner will be attending a substance abuse treatment center for **more than 1 day**
- (2) Pre-Trial prisoner will be admitted to a medical facility for **more than 1 day**, except for emergencies
- (3) Pre-Trial prisoner will be attending admin separation board and will NOT require further confinement; this would be a permanent release.
