PERMANENTLY RELEASE OF A POST-TRIAL PRISONER

The following information and checklist is provided to assist you in permanently releasing a post-trial prisoner from the PEARL HARBOR BRIG:

In almost all cases, the Brig computes prisoner sentences and will inform Commands if they have a responsibility to pick up a post-trial prisoner at release.

Pearl Harbor is a 90-day post-trial facility, consider the following:

- * Prisoners with more than 90 days <u>left to serve</u>, on the date of sentencing to confinement, will be designated for transfer to a mainland facility and the Command is not responsible for permanent release; other Service headquarters (i.e. USMC, Army and Air Force) through MOA's are responsible to transfer their prisoners and may task local units with the responsibility.
- * Prisoners with less than 90 days left to serve, on the date of sentencing to confinement, will be release back to their Command on the permanent release date. The exception is for some Navy prisoners who will be transferred to TPU.

Only the presiding Courts Martial Convening Authority can affect release prior to the Brig's calculated release date by "remission of sentence."

Remission of sentence by the Convening Authority should be coordinated through the respective military Service and installation legal office.

Installation legal can coordinate with Brig liaisons at the above contact numbers.
