RMKS/1. References (a) and (b) establish requirements and provide guidance
for the Department of the Navy (DON) for entering into Security Support
Agreements (SSA) between Commands and/or Program Executive Offices.

2. This ALNAV further establishes the DON policy directing commands to enter
into a SSA when providing or receiving any security services for any security
function in addition to references (a) and (b). Security functions requiring
a SSA include but are not limited to Operations Security and Physical
Security.

3. Commands may perform specified security functions for other commands
through a SSA. Such agreements may be appropriate in situations where
security, economy, and efficiency are considerations, including but not
limited to:

- a. A command providing security services for another command, or for a
tenant activity;
- b. A command located on premises of another government entity, where the
host command performs security functions under a negotiated agreement;
- c. A senior command in the chain of command performing or delegating
security functions for subordinate commands;
- d. A command with particular expertise or capability performing a
specialized security function for another command;
- e. A command established expressly to provide centralized service (e.g.,
Personnel Support Activity or Human Resources Office); and
- f. Situations in which a cleared contractor facility or long-term
visitor group is physically located on a Navy or Marine Corps installation.

4. Per reference (a), enclosure (4), section 11, commands will ensure when
specified security functions are performed by or for other activities, an SSA

whether a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) or Memorandums of Agreement (MOA) is executed.

a. This ALNAV establishes the requirement for the head of each activity to sign the MOU/MOA.

5. Reference (b) reinforces DON policy for establishing clear, documented security responsibilities to ensure proper protection of personnel, information, and assets across all DON activities.

6. Compliance with this ALNAV ensures proper governance, accountability, and execution of shared security responsibilities across the DON.

7. This ALNAV supplements the references and is effective immediately. The content of this ALNAV will be incorporated in the revision of the applicable DON security program instructions to include but not limited to SECNAVINST 5500.35, the Department of the Navy Physical Security Program, and SECNAVINST 3070.2A, Operations Security.

8. Commanders authorizing individuals to enter into a SSA under this ALNAV will promulgate implementing instructions.
