NAVADMIN 074/23 announces the Academic Year 2024 Medical Enlisted Commissioning Program application information. Applications for Annual Year Medical Enlisted Commissioning Program (MECP) must be postmarked by **Sept. 1, 2023**.

### Who needs to know?

- Enlisted Sailors interested in commissioning as a Nurse Corps Officer
- Enlisted Leaders, Enlisted Mentors
- Navy Medical Professionals
- Command Triads

### What you need to know – key points

- The Medical Commissioning Program is a commissioning pathway for enlisted Sailors that grants up to 36 months to complete a bachelor's of science in nursing
  - There are two pathways, one for those who possess a qualifying degree/RN license and another for those who need to complete their nursing degree
- Applications are due by Sept. 1, 2023.

### Sample POD/POW Notes

### FAQ

#### Q. What are the requirements to apply?

A. The Program Authorization contains full details. Applicants must be commissioned prior their 42<sup>nd</sup> birthday, have a minimum of 45 quarter or 30 semester hours in undergraduate courses concentrated in the sciences completed with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and have a certified SAT or ACT score no older than 3 years from application due date (Sept. 1, 2020).

#### Q. Are any requirements waiverable?

A. As per the Program Authorization, no waivers are available for those who need to complete their nursing degree and pass the NCLEX. Enlisted who possess a qualifying nursing degree (bachelor's in nursing accredited by the ACEN or CCNE) and have already passed the NCLEX should email the Community Manager directly for guidance at [heather.b.ray2.mil@us.navy.mil](mailto:heather.b.ray2.mil@us.navy.mil).

A. Applications must be postmarked by Sept. 1, 2023, and mailed to:
