RMKS/1. Request all Active Duty and Reserve Component Sailors participate in the Navy's annual Health of the Force (HoF) survey. This voluntary and confidential survey will remain open from 21 April to 30 June 2025. It takes about 20 minutes to complete and can be accessed on military or personal computers and on mobile devices at:
https://usnavy.gov1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_9L8ntWOU5S12DdQ or via the QR code located on the Fact Sheet accompanying this NAVADMIN.

2. Although participation in the survey is optional, a best practice is to incorporate the survey into daily battle rhythms or duty section trainings, to encourage Sailor participation at every level.

3. To access the survey, participants will be asked to provide their Department of Defense identification number. This information is only used to limit participation to Navy Service Members and to minimize unnecessary demographic questions. At no point will Navy link answers back to the individual.

4. HoF data is critical to assessing Navy's understanding of factors impacting Navy warfighter effectiveness, retention, and readiness. In addition, this survey will assess the impact of Quality of Service initiatives.

5. This year, the online dashboard will enable communities to monitor their participation in the survey in real time. For information on how to access this dashboard, please contact the Navy Survey Office.

6. In addition to this NAVADMIN, Sailors with a valid email address in Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System should receive an e-mail with details on how to access the survey.
