RMKS/1. This message provides an update to the United States Naval Community College (USNCC) degree and certificate programs available to students for FY26 and solicits applications for two online asynchronous Academic Faculty positions.

A. The USNCC has opened new programs in artificial intelligence and data analytics designed to enhance warfighter development. USNCC now offers over 40 Naval-relevant, regionally accredited associate programs and professional certificates. All degrees provide credit for military training and are awarded with a built-in pathway to 4-year degree programs at partner institutions. Tuition, books and fees are fully funded for enlisted service members. Courses are 100% online and asynchronous to avoid interference with duty requirements. B. Additionally, USNCC is seeking highly motivated and qualified E9s for two online asynchronous Academic Faculty positions. This NAVADMIN solicits enlisted applications meeting the academic institution requirements delineated in paragraph 3. Submission packages must be received via email to CSEL@usncc.edu no later than 10 April 2026. USNCC review and follow-on selection notifications will be made no later than 05 June 2026.

2. Program Updates.

A. New degree programs offered include:

- (1) Associate of Arts in General Studies with Artificial Intelligence Specialization, University of Maryland Global Campus
- (2) Associate of Arts in General Studies with Data Analytics Specialization, University of Maryland Global Campus
- (3) Associate of Science in Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence, Arizona State University

B. Standalone certificates are available for each of the above-mentioned degree programs. Programs offered include:

(1) Certificate in Artificial Intelligence Foundations, University of Maryland Global Campus

(2) Certificate in Data Analytics, University of Maryland Global Campus

(3) Certificate in Foundations of Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence, Arizona State University

3. Academic Faculty Eligibility.

A. Personnel selected for the unique and demanding Academic Faculty positions for a three-year duty will represent the hundreds of thousands of Sailors serving throughout the United States Navy across the U.S. and abroad. Applicants must meet the service administrative and USNCC academic requirements listed below to be considered:

(1) Applicants with a projected rotation date (PRD) of November 2026 or earlier are eligible.

(2) Applicants beyond the above projected rotation date (PRD) may apply with command and detailer approval.

(3) Applicants selected may detach from their current command as early as detailer approved.

(4) Applicants must have passed the most recent (within the last year) PFA and be within body fat standards.

(5) Applicants must pass Flag Screening IAW REF B.

(6) Academic Faculty applicants must have completed an accredited graduate degree that supports teaching at least one of the following topics at the college 100 series course level; US Naval History, Political Science, Naval Force Design, International Affairs, Ethics, English, Critical Thinking, and/or Math.

(7) Experience teaching in an online asynchronous community college setting is preferred but not required.

4. Academic Faculty position submission package must contain the following documents:

A. Last 5 years of evaluations (all SSNs redacted).

B. Biography with official photo (2 pages maximum).

C. Proof of formal education with a minimum of a master's degree (submit all relevant college level transcripts - All SSNs and student IDs redacted)

D. Command endorsement from CO or Commander.

E. Personal letter describing why applicant desires to teach at the USNCC and the value of higher education for the enlisted ranks (1 page maximum).
