RMKS/1. This NAVADMIN announces the Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 Permanent Military Professor (PMP) selection board for officers reporting to graduate school in August 2027. The FY27 PMP selection board may select up to a total of 14 PMPs from a pool of eligible Active Duty, Training and Administration of the Reserves, and Selected Reserve Officer applicants for assignment to the United States Naval Academy, Naval War College or Naval Postgraduate School (NPS).

Applicants must be released by their current community.
