RMKS/1. THIS ORDER TO ACCOUNT APPLIES TO ALL NAVY ACTIVE DUTY, RESERVE, DON  
CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES, NAF EMPLOYEES, NEX EMPLOYEES, OVERSEAS CONTRACTORS, AND  
APPLICABLE DEPENDENTS WITHIN THE ESTABLISHED GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF INTEREST  
(GAOI) DESIGNATED IN PARAGRAPH 2. ECHELON II COMMANDERS AND ALL REGIONAL  
COMMANDERS SHALL ENSURE WIDEST DISSEMINATION TO ALL SUBORDINATE AND TENANT  
COMMANDS AND DETACHMENTS FOR IMMEDIATE ACTION UPON RECEIPT.

2. THE FOLLOWING GAOI HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR GUAM TYPHOON SINLAKU:  
ALL U.S. TERRITORY OF GUAM, ROTA, TINIAN AND SAIPAN.

3. ALL COMMANDS ARE EXPECTED TO:

A. ENSURE YOUR COMMAND'S NAVY FAMILY ACCOUNTABILITY AND ASSESSMENT SYSTEM  
(NFAAS) DATABASE IS CURRENT AND ACCURATE, INCLUDING ALL PHONE NUMBERS AND  
ADDRESSES. ENSURE ANY RECENTLY CHECKED-IN PERSONNEL WHOSE CONTACT  
INFORMATION HAS NOT YET BEEN UPDATED IN NFAAS PROVIDE RECALL INFORMATION  
THROUGH THEIR RESPECTIVE CHAIN OF COMMAND UNTIL THEIR RECORDS ARE UPDATED.  
ADDITIONALLY, ENSURE DESIGNATED COR(S) ARE PROPERLY ASSIGNED IN NFAAS FOR  
EACH OF YOUR COMMAND UICS.

B. FOLLOWING STORM PASSAGE OR CLOSEST POINT OF APPROACH (CPA), COMMANDS MUST  
MUSTER AND ACCOUNT FOR ALL NAVY ACTIVE DUTY, RESERVE PERSONNEL, DON CIVILIAN  
EMPLOYEES, NAF EMPLOYEES, NEX EMPLOYEES, OVERSEAS CONTRACTORS, AND APPLICABLE  
DEPENDENTS WITHIN THE GAOI.

ALL COR(S)/SPONSORS IN THE AFFECTED GAOI WILL RECEIVE NOTIFICATION FROM NFAAS  
VIA TEXT OR EMAIL TO MUSTER THEMSELVES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS IN NFAAS. CO(S)  
AND/OR COR(S) WILL ENSURE THE WIDEST DISSEMINATION OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR  
ACCURATE AND TIMELY ACCOUNTABILITY VIA NFAAS. IF PERSONNEL ARE UNABLE TO  
ACCESS NFAAS, CO(S)/COR(S) WILL DETERMINE THE ACCURATE STATUS AND WHEREABOUTS  
OF THEIR PERSONNEL AND MUSTER AND ACCOUNT FOR THEM AS AT HOME, AT WORK,  
TELEWORKING, EVACUATED, DISPLACED, OR NOT IN THE GAOI WITH THE SPECIFIED

CIRCUMSTANCE (DEPLOYED, TDY/TAD/IA, ON LEAVE, SEPARATED/ RETIRED, TRANSFERRED, UA/DESERTER, OR OTHER) .

C. COMMANDS SHALL DIRECT COR(S)/SPONSORS TO MUSTER IN NFAAS AT <https://navyfamily.navy.mil/>. IF NFAAS IS UNAVAILABLE, COMMANDS AND MEMBERS SHALL REPORT PERSONNEL ACCOUNTABILITY (PA) STATUS TO THE AFFECTED REGION OPERATIONS CENTER (ROC) OR THROUGH THEIR DIRECT CHAIN OF COMMAND.

D. DO NOT DELAY REPORTING PERSONNEL ACCOUNTABILITY UNTIL ALL INFORMATION IS COMPLETE. REPORT MUSTERING INFORMATION AS IT IS OBTAINED, AND UPDATE ACCORDINGLY. INCLUDE ANY AMPLIFYING INFORMATION IN THE NOTES FIELD OF THE INDIVIDUALS ACCOUNTING LINE IN NFAAS.

4. ALL COR(S)/SPONSORS ARE EXPECTED TO:

A. ACCOUNT FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS IN NFAAS AT <https://navyfamily.navy.mil/>.

B. IF UNABLE TO ACCESS NFAAS, SPONSORS SHALL CONTACT THEIR COR, COMMAND MUSTERING OFFICER, OR SUPERVISOR TO CHECK IN (MUSTER) .

C. SPONSORS SHALL PROVIDE COMMAND REPRESENTATIVES WITH THEIR CURRENT RESIDENCE, DISPLACED LOCATION, OR, IF NOT IN THE GAOI, THEIR SPECIFIED CIRCUMSTANCE (DEPLOYED, TDY/TAD/IA, ON LEAVE, SEPARATED/RETIRED, TRANSFERRED, UA/DESERTER, OTHER) .

5. NEEDS ASSESSMENT IS NOT BEING INITIATED .
