1. Policy

- a. Per reference (a) and MILPERSMAN 1640-060, enlisted Service members or officers who are adjudged, by a courtmartial, a sentence of 30 days or less of military confinement and does not include a punitive discharge or dismissal (as applicable) must be issued temporary duty (TDY) assignment orders to a designated confinement facility. When this occurs, Service members will return to their previous duty station for further disposition by their parent command. All other confinement is addressed in MILPERSMAN 1640-070. Per MILPERSMAN 1626-030 and 1640-060 through 1640-100, Service members who are confined for less than 31 days or 31 days or more and not awarded an unsuspended punitive discharge or dismissal will normally be returned to their previous duty station. members confined while en route to a new duty station will be reassigned to another comparable duty assignment. Occasionally, there will be circumstances in which the return of a released prisoner would not be in the best interest of the command or the individual.
- b. In these cases, commanding officers should (at the time of confinement) submit a message to Navy Personnel Command (NAVPERSCOM) (applicable detailer) requesting the Service member not be returned to the command. NAVPERSCOM will initiate action for reassignment of the Service member to another comparable duty assignment. The message must be submitted per guidelines listed below:
- (1) Rated and Designated Service Members. The message must be sent to NAVPERSCOM (applicable detailer).

- (2) Non-Rated and Non-Designated Service Members. The message must be sent to NAVPERSCOM, Shore Special Programs Distribution Branch (PERS-4010).
- (3) The activity where the brig or military correctional facility is located and the local discipline and or Pay/Personnel Support System (PASS) office that serves the brig or military correctional facility must be an information addressee to allow for proper submission of the availability report.
- (4) The message must state the date the Service member was confined or transferred TDY for confinement and the reason why the Service member should not be returned to the command (e.g., loss of security clearance, loss of Navy enlisted classification qualification, morale, and or Service member's return would pose danger to his or her wellbeing).
