1. <u>Scope</u>. Patrol crew billets require duty in arduous field environments (many times isolated and independent), supporting surface and special warfare operations around the world. Crew members are expected to cross-train and attain watch qualifications that are beyond the scope of their regular ratings' duties.

2. Eligibility Requirements

- a. Members must be eligible for a secret clearance. The member's command will initiate a background investigation per reference (a).
- b. Member must meet standards set forth in reference (b) to include having participated in and passed the most recent physical fitness assessment.
 - c. Eliqible to carry a weapon per reference (c).
- d. Completion of sections A, B, C, and D of NAVPERS 1306/92 Special Program Screening. NAVPERS 1306/92 may be accessed by using the following Web address: https://www.mynavyhr.navy.mil/References/Forms/NAVPERS/.
- e. Requests for waivers of above criteria must be approved by the gaining command's immediate superior in command.
