1. Pursuant to reference (a), your request for an Exception to Policy permitting Clinical Case Staff Meetings (CCSMs) to be held within 30 calendar days following receipt of a Family Advocacy Program (FAP) allegation that meets the reasonable suspicion threshold for abuse, has been approved.

2. This approval recognizes the critical importance of convening subject matter experts in a timely manner to ensure effective safety planning, coordinated clinical intervention, and comprehensive support services for Sailors and their families.
