

Invalid Discrepancy Codes

Reported when the laboratory was unable to finalize confirmatory testing for routine samples, due to either chromatographic interference or depletion of the specimen during the course of testing.

1. An invalid result call is not a reason for requiring a custody form review.
2. An invalid result call is not a reason for freezing a sample.
3. LIMS does not support calling a specimen invalid with no other results. If no result could be obtained for ALL drugs tested, then the sample should be assigned at least one non-testable discrepancy, such as BC (Bottle Leaked, Quantity Not Sufficient), SA (Suspected Adulteration), SC (Quantity Not Sufficient), or OY (Lab Technical Discrepancy, such as lab accident).
4. An invalid result call shall not be used for non-punitive or punitive action of any kind.
5. A Command may consider a re-collection event or increased testing frequency on that SM.
6. An invalid result does not necessarily mean the specimen is adulterated.

Invalid Discrepancy Code Notes:

01 should not appear, as all standard drug classes and analytes have been mapped.
 09 would be used if THC is called invalid, as opposed to THC8 (44) or THC9 (45).
 14 would be used if AOPI is called invalid.
 15 would be used if HYDRO is called invalid.
