Procedure Update: NAVY-WIDE ADVANCEMENT EXAMINATION (NWAE) OUTSTANDING DISCREPANCIES AND OUTSTANDING CYCLE 247 E-6 AND E-5 ANSWER SHEETS

BLUF: 1. All CY105 & CY244 remaining discrepancies have been placed in NETPDC INVAL, due to no command response to posted discrepancies.

2. For NWAE Cycles 246, 247 and 106, please review your discrepancies in the Navy Enlisted Advancement System (NEAS) (<https://prod-neas.ncdc.navy.mil/LoginWebBatch.aspx>) and take the appropriate action to correct. (Summary of discrepancies: Cycle 246 – 57, Cycle 247 – 2,412 and Cycle 106 – 696)

3. There are still numerous outstanding NWAE E-6 and E-5 answer sheets for Cycles 247 (Active) and 106 (Reserve) that have not yet been submitted.

Discussion: 1. Per policy, any outstanding discrepancies with no command response are to be placed in NETPDC INVAL two weeks after results are published/released. NETPDC will continue to work CY105 / CY244 EAW Post-exam Admin Comments (PAC) submissions through limiting date 30JUN2020.

2. Failure to submit corrections to discrepant exam records in a timely manner will result in your Sailors NWAE to become NETPDC INVAL.

3. Submit all NWAE E-6 and E-5 answers sheets for Cycles 247 (Active) and 106 (Reserve) in accordance with BUPERSINST 1430.16G as soon as possible.

What this means to you: Review all your exam discrepant records and take immediate appropriate action to correct. Submit all completed answer sheets on hand for Cycles 247 (Active) and 106 (Reserve). Let's take care of the future leaders of our Navy.
