## PROCEDURE UPDATE: EMERGENCY AUTHORITY FOR VOLUNTARY EXTENSION DUE TO LAPSE IN APPROPRIATION

Release Date: 11/06/2025 Effective Date: Immediately

<u>BLUF</u>: By direction of the Chief of Naval Personnel, Sailors with SEAOS on 5 December 2025 or earlier who are unable to separate due to the FY-26 lapse in appropriations may execute a voluntary extension not to exceed 30 days. This extension allows for additional time to ensure continuation of benefits and execution of separation requirements under MILPERSMAN 1160-040, par. 5 (Commanding Officer (CO) and Officer-In-Charge (OIC) Extension Authority).

**<u>DISCUSSION</u>**: Sailors with SEAOS on 5 December 2025 or earlier that cannot be separated due to the FY-26 lapse in appropriations may execute a voluntary extension for a period of 30 days.

**PROCEDURES**: A NPPSC 1160/1 *Command Career Request* is not required for requests under this Ops Alert. The required KSD for extension under this Ops Alert is the NAVPERS 1070/621 *Agreement to Extend Enlistment*. When generating the NAVPERS 1070/621 in NSIPS, command will use the following information:

- Extensions Months Other: 1
- Officer Name/Grade & Title: contract may be signed by direction.
- Under "Exceptions" Tab (see example below):
  - o Contract Clause: 027 (NAVPERSCOM Approval)
  - Exceptions: Substitute template language with the following: "I agree to voluntarily extend my current enlistment for 30 days IAW Ops Alert 029-25 to allow additional time for processing of separation requirements due to the FY-26 lapse in appropriations."

Contract Clause: 0.	NAVPERSCOM Approval
Exceptions: I agree to voluntarily extend my current enlistment for 30 days IAW Ops Alert 029-25 to allo additional time for processing of separation requirements due to the FY-26 lapse in appropriations.	

**NOTE**: If a warning message appears indicating that "Member's EAOS is currently expired", click "Ok" and continue with contract generation.
