AMPN/REF A IS ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF WAR MEMORANDUM AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE DANGER AREA DESIGNATIONS FOR UNITED STATES EUROPEAN COMMAND AND UNITED STATES INDO-PACIFIC COMMAND.

GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. Pass to commanding officers, executive officers, senior enlisted leaders, administrative officers, personnel officers, command career counselors, Command Pay and Personnel Administrators (CPPAs), and disbursing officers. This message targets personnel, administrative, disbursing offices, Transaction Service Centers (TSCs), and Regional Support Centers (RSCs) regarding current personnel, pay, and transportation services for both active and reserve personnel.

2. Reference (a) authorizes the following locations as imminent danger areas for purpose of Imminent Danger Pay (IDP):

- A. The land and air domains of Island of Cyprus.
- B. The land and air domains of the Island of Crete.
- C. The sea and air domains of the Eastern Mediterranean Sea located east of longitude 20 degrees east, including the Aegean and Levantine Seas.
- D. The sea and air domains of the Black Sea.
- E. The air domain of Azerbaijan.
- F. The entire land and air domains of Turkey, removing the current exclusion of Izmir and Turkish Straits.
- G. The land, air, and sea domains of Diego Garcia, the Chagos Archipelago to include the Maldives.
- H. The air and sea domains within the Indian Ocean that lie north of 10 degrees south latitude, west of 90 degrees east longitude, and east of 68 degrees east longitude.

3. This imminent danger area designation was effective 28 February 2026 and will end the third month beginning after the

conclusion of Operation Epic Fury or any follow-on operation directed by the President of the United States.

4. The monthly rate for IDP is 225.00 per month, prorated at 7.50 per day. Service Members may not receive concurrent payments of Hostile Fire Pay and IDP.
